

MINUTES OF MEETING OF BELNAP
FAMILY ORGANIZATION OFFICERS October 24, 1964

The meeting of this organization was held at the home of Della Belnap. Lorenzo Belnap conducted the meeting and it was opened with prayer by Della Belnap. Time : 7:00

Ronald Belnap made a report on some names that have been found for sealing. The Salt Lake Temple requested that the sealing be done there. Sixteen people are needed to do this sealing: 7 couples and 2 men for witnesses.

President Lorenzo Belnap suggested that we try again to get the records from Salt Lake. In case this could not be done, a tentative date, Thursday, November 5, 1964, was set to do this work. Vice President Ronald Belnap was appointed to supervise and Keith Belnap was appointed to get the people to do the work.

Della Belnap put forth a question as to where names from England (if there were some) should be sent. The group decided that they should be divided among the Salt Lake, Logan, and Idaho Falls, temples.

The motion was made and seconded to have Artelle Luthy remain as treasurer of the organization due to her location in Ogden. She was appointed a part of the secretarial committee. Appreciation to her for her work as secretary was expressed by the group.

A letter was read by Della Belnap from Brother Christiansen that the family group sheets are in the archives and this letter will be put into the minutes.

Flora Dotson read the letter that she and Della had been assigned to write. The letter was approved by the group and ~~Ronald~~ Ronald Belnap will print it.

It was suggested that each of the children of Gilbert have a family representative to be appointed to the board of directors of the main organization and also have reunions of their own.

A document of the contents of the Belnap Family Files was read by Lorenzo and is now in the minute book.

A report regarding the cost of the printing of the book was made by President Lorenzo Belnap. The woman who printed the book felt that she should have more money. It was not known whether the former president, Gordon L. Belnap, had agreed to pay her this extra money or not. -It- Keith Belnap made the motion to pay the full cost that she asked if it had been promised and to pay the compromise she had proposed if not.

The expenditures for the preparation of the Gilbert Belnap book were also reported.

Meeting adjourned at 10:10 am for 3 months.
