7. All members of the family organization are asked to send in anysheets of research to the family organization to be placed in the file.
8. The book for the B.Y.U. will have to be taken apart and documented on each page. There is a need for typists in the family organization, as well as a central committee, to help file, copy and check incoming sheets. The other \$50.00 books are placed in Logan, Cache Genealogical Library; Boise, L.D.S. and State Library and Idaho Historical and Genalogical Library; Idaho Falls, L.D.S. Genealogical Library; and two films in Salt Lake; and also in books in the patron's file.
