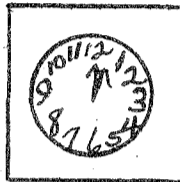

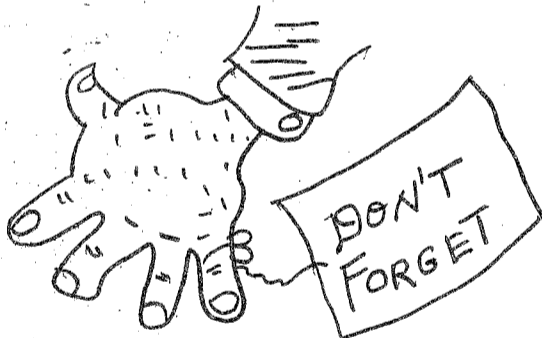

APRIL 14, 1952 BUSINESS MEETING.

A Business meeting of the Presidency held April 14, 1952 at Ogden, Utah. Lester Belnap, Volney Belnap and Della Belnap Attending.

Topics discussed were;

1. The Reunion to be held in Aug. 1952 on Saturday in Idaho. The town and the place to be decided upon by the Idaho Commette. The date of the reunion by the Board of Directors.
2. That a new Genealogist be appointed.
3. That all Belnap Family Organization Records should be filed in one place. A copy should be made of all available records. If possible a set of files should be obtained. A report on prices to be given at the next meeting.
4. It would be advisable if the material collected by the Historian were put in book form and filed with other family records, so this information might be preserved.
5. Previous records, such as former minute Books should be obtained and filed also.
6. An inventory sheet of all records filed should ^{also} be kept by the President.
7. What material should be prepared for addition to the Book that was started last time. It was suggested that a history of Adaline and Henrietta Belnap be written. And their childrens pictures should be added.
