September the 21 - A D 1846

Br Bigham we arrived in this place last evening: and was accompanied by Leather Morby to - William Grapers and he learned from him that nine horses and three mules were conducted on the Island by three persons: Nine of those horses were loose without saddles or bridles nor pistols about them: The three persons had no appearance weapons ~~was~~ about them whatever: And from the best information that we can get one of the men was once a trader in this place and is now passing through and has taken his horses there for safety to prevent them from scattering:

we are about to start for the mouth of the flat river and before we return we will know who they are and where they going
