MEMBRANE 8d.

- May 28. Commission to the abbot of Gloucester and the prior of Llanthony
Westminster. by Gloucester to survey in the presence of the constable of the castle of Gloucester all defects in the houses, walls, towers and other buildings and dykes of the said castle, and to certify the king by the octaves of Trinity of what defects there are and of the estimated cost of repairing them.
- May 30. Commission *de wallis et fossatis* to John Cavendissh, Roger de
Westminster. Kirketon, William de Thorpe, John Colvile, 'chivaler,' John Holt, Thomas Holbech, Thomas Pynchebek, Thomas de Welles and William de Petteworth on the sea coast in the towns of Wysbech, Elm, Welles, March, Marchford, and Tyd, co. Cambridge.

Wychyngham, John Holt, Nicholas Styuecle, John Cheyne, Fulk Grey and William Wylyngham, on complaint by Thomas Swafham of Burwell that, whereas the king lately took him, his men, servants and goods into his special protection, Payn Typtoft, John Kent of Burwell, Robert de Fordeham, William de Swafham, John Carlewayn, John son of Richard Sone of Burwell, William Bailly of Burwell, Philip Chamberlayn of Burwell, Gilbert Oky of Burwell, and others, broke his close at Burwell, co. Cambridge, while he was so under protection, assaulted him and carried away his goods.
