Nov. 20. *Inspeximus* and confirmation of letters patent dated 24 February, Westminster. 13 Richard II, granting to William Parker and others divers lands in the county of Kent late of Robert Bealknap. For 40s. paid in the hanaper.

Nov. 16. Grant for life to the king's servant William Cook of 6*d.* daily from the Westminster. custom of the town of Bristol. By p.s.

Nov. 4. *Inspeximus* and confirmation to Adam Penkhyrst of letters patent dated Westminster. 23 March, 1 Richard II, inspecting and confirming letters patent dated 14 April, 44 Edward III, granting to him for life 6*d.* daily at the Exchequer. By p.s. and for $\frac{1}{2}$ mark paid in the hanaper.
Vacated by surrender and cancelled, because on 20 April the king granted to him 6d. daily for life from the issues of the counties of Surrey and Sussex.

Nov. 1. Grant to Ranulph del See, esquire, that he shall be one of the king's Westminster. serjeants at arms, receiving for life 12*d.* daily for his wages at the hands of the sheriffs of the city of York and a livery yearly at Christmas as other serjeants at arms have. By p.s.
Vacated by surrender and cancelled, because on 22 June, in the second year, the king granted to him the said 12d. daily from the said 1 November for life from the issues of the city.

Dec. 6. Grant for life to Conan Filz Henry of 20*l.* yearly at the Exchequer. Westminster. By p.s.

Dec. 9. Grant for life to John Hareshom of 3*d.* daily at the Exchequer. Westminster. By p.s.

Grant to John Huet *alias* Sergeant that he shall be one of the king's serjeants at arms, receiving for life 20*l.* yearly at the Exchequer and a livery yearly at the great wardrobe at Christmas as other serjeants at arms have. By p.s.

Dec. 10. *Inspeximus* and confirmation to John Dolyng of letters patent dated Westminster. 29 July, 19 Richard II, granting to him for life the office of ranger of the New Forest and 6*d.* daily. By p.s. and for 10s. paid in the hanaper.

Dec. 12. Licence for the provincial of the order of friars of St. Mary of Mount Westminster. Carmel and all priors and superiors of the order in England to bring to obedience certain friars of the order, chaplains of the apostolic see and others, who have abused the privileges granted to them by the apostolic see, in accordance with bulls of the pope. [*F'adera.*]

Nov. 11. Grant for life to the king's esquire John Ayschele, whom the king has Westminster. retained for life, of the castle of Emelyn in South Wales with all accustomed profits, rents and services to the value of 80 marks yearly as Simon Burley, 'chivaler,' deceased, had, provided that he answer for any surplus yearly at the Exchequer.
