The "Rosemauer Burg" a castle that the
Turks sieged many times but never captured
there is a well in this castle that was 146
meters deep but now has been filled up to about
98 meters deep. It is cut in solid rock.

There is room for 400 families to live and
in war time the whole town retreated into
the walls which were the only protection they
had. It was built in 1222 by German knights
and the tower rebuilt 1623.
