Dear Brother:

Your recommendation of Elder Hyrum Belnap as a representative of the Genealogical Society in Ogden Stake is satisfactory and we have notified him of his appointment. Our committee has commenced a vigorous campaign under instructions of Pres. Lund and officers of the Genealogical Society to increase our membership to 10,000. The importance of the work you will readily recognize and endorse. We desire to avail ourselves of the Genealogical works now being published in our own and other countries, and establish a fund to enable us to secure such works as fast as they are published for the benefit of our members and to aid the Saints in their Genealogical research for temple work. We feel that our Stake representative and, wherever convenient, a member of our committee should attend the Stake Priesthood meeting or High Council meeting for the purpose of first securing the co-operation of our Stake Authorities.
