Baptised in the Font before I went
back to Ohio, we met Joseph, Spoke
and the Font, ^{was} Dedicated and he
Joseph said Blessed is the first man
Baptised in this Font. Brigham
Young Baptised me. I was Baptised
Six Times. Joseph took off his
mantle and Wrapt it around me
took me in his Carriage and, drove
to your House He Talked all the
way going to your House and
