A Blessing given by John Smith Patriarch
upon the head of Hyrum Nelson son of Silbert and
and ~~Estaline~~ Estaline Nelson born Ogden City Weber
County W. T. March 24th 1858

Brother Hyrum Thou art of the house of Israel and num-
bered with the sons of Zion Thou art of the lineage of Ephraim
and an heir to the blessings of the New and Everlasting Covenant
with the Gifts and Privileges of the Priesthood it is thy
privilege and duty to travel and proclaim the words of life
and salvation among the nations of the Earth it is the will
of the Lord that you should become a mighty man in Israel
and raise thy voice in mighty power where so ever thou
shalt sojourn seek to know the will of the Lord and His
Spirit will rest upon thee and thou shalt have the Gift of

Deceasement and shall have power over thine Enemies and shall
 assist in avenging the blood of the saints and Prophets which was shed
 by the ungodly the wicked shall tremble at the sound of thy voice
 The Angel who was given thee at thy birth shall watch over thee
 by day and by night and warn thee of dangers and ward off the sho-
 ts of the adversary which may be hurled at thee thou shalt also
 have the gifts of healing the sick by the laying on of hands
 In due season thou shalt have a companion to suit thy condi-
 tion and thy posterity shall be numerous and bear thy name in
 honorable remembrance from generation to generation thou shalt
 be numbered among the Hundred and forty four thousand
